Rules tip of the month – A B C

Do you forget the options for taking relief from a lateral (red) water hazard? Remember your A B Cs... **A** = go **ALL** the way back to where you hit your previous shot / **B** = drop **BEHIND** the hazard on a line between where the ball last crossed the hazard and the hole / **C** = drop within two **CLUB** lengths from where the ball last crossed the hazard, not nearer the hole.

 <b>2019 Rules Preview</b>	 <b>Golf Genius Tip</b>
<p><b>Ball Moved During Search</b> – If a player accidentally moves his or her ball during search, there will be no penalty. Replace the ball.</p> <p>Why the change? It is inconsistent to encourage opponents, fellow competitors, and caddies to look for the ball without risk, whereas if the player searches and accidentally moves it, the player is penalized.</p>	<p>When creating a multiple day event, if the format being played is the <b>same</b> for all days, create a multi-round tournament. If the playing format is <b>different</b> for each day and you want to aggregate the results, first create each format individually within its own round.</p> <p>Once finished, add a new linked tournament choosing each round whose results you want to link together. On the leaderboard, each individual round will be shown as T1, T2, etc.</p>
