## Rules tip of the month – Can you borrow a club?

Partners may share clubs, provided that the total number of clubs carried by the partners does not exceed fourteen.

You may NOT borrow a club from a fellow competitor. If you do, you incur a 2-stroke penalty for a breach of Rule 4-4a. So – if you left a club on a previous hole – go back and get it.



 <b>2019 Rules Preview</b>	 <b>Golf Genius Tip</b>
<p><b>Accidental Deflections</b> – including when the ball hits the player or opponent or their equipment or caddies, there will be NO penalty and the ball will be played as it lies (with limited exceptions).</p> <p>To address any concerns that a player might deliberately position equipment to act as a backstop and potentially deflect his or her ball, there will be a penalty if the ball hits equipment that was positioned for that purpose.</p>	<p>Be sure to have your golf course specific information for all tees in Golf Genius – yardage, rating, slope and handicap allocation – before you create your pairings.</p> <p>If playing a 9-hole round, be sure to input the 9-hole slope and rating, otherwise you will not be able to post the scores.</p>
